Lodge members and staff from Midwest Cancer Alliance are teaming up with health professionals from University of Kansas Medical Center to provide health services that include:

- Free Skin Cancer Screenings
- Free Prostate Cancer Screenings
- Free Screen-to-Save Colon Cancer Home Screening Kits
- Body Mass Index (BMI) Assessments

This community outreach event is one of 28 being held across the state this year by the Kansas Masonic Foundation and is open to the public.

Dozens of area Masons work with the Kansas Masonic Foundation to coordinate each of the free screening events that often draw several hundred attendees of all ages. According to Brooke Groneman, the outreach director for MCA, nearly 7,000 Kansas residents have attended the screenings since 2003.
